One

1 Corinthians 15:3-4 - For I handed on to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures; that he was buried; that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures;

(+) 1 Corinthians 15:14 - And if Christ has not been raised, then empty [too] is our preaching; empty, too, your faith.

John 13:1 - Before the feast of Passover, Jesus knew that his hour had come to pass from this world to the Father. He loved his own in the world and he loved them to the end.

John 15:3 - You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you.

Galatians 2:20 - yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me; insofar as I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God who has loved me and given himself up for me.

Ephesians 5:2 - and live in love, as Christ loved us and handed himself over for us as a sacrificial offering to God for a fragrant aroma.

1 Corinthians 2:16 - For “who has known the mind of the Lord, so as to counsel him?” But we have the mind of Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:11 - Among human beings, who knows what pertains to a person except the spirit of the person that is within? Similarly, no one knows what pertains to God except the Spirit of God.

Galatians 1:9 - As we have said before, and now I say again, if anyone preaches to you a gospel other than the one that you received, let that one be accursed!

(1x) Romans 5:19 - For just as through the disobedience of one person the many were made sinners, so through the obedience of one the many will be made righteous. (2 gardens – Eden & Gethsemane)

Hebrews 5:9 - and when he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him,

1 Peter 2:24 - He himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

2 Corinthians 5:21 - For our sake he made him to be sin who did not know sin, so that we might become the righteousness of God in him.

Galatians 3:13 - Christ ransomed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written, "Cursed be everyone who hangs on a tree,"

Matthew 27:46 - And about three o'clock Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "*Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?*" which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Hebrews 5:8 - Son though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered;

Isaiah 53:4-5 - Yet it was our pain that he bore, our sufferings he endured. We thought of him as stricken, struck down by God and afflicted, But he was pierced for our sins, crushed for our iniquity. He bore the punishment that makes us whole, by his wounds we were healed.

Isaiah 53:11 - Because of his anguish he shall see the light; because of his knowledge he shall be content; My servant, the just one, shall justify the many, their iniquity he shall bear.

Absolute confidence destroyed death

Hebrews 5:7 - In the days when he was in the flesh, he offered prayers and supplications with loud cries and tears to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence.

(2x) Romans 5:19 - For just as through the disobedience of one person the many were made sinners, so through the obedience of one the many will be made righteous.

1 Corinthians 12:26 - If [one] part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy. (think body parts)

Mark 3:35 - [For] whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

Acts 4:19 - Peter and John, however, said to them in reply, "Whether it is right in the sight of God for us to obey you rather than God, you be the judges.

John 8:29 - The one who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, because I always do what is pleasing to him."

John 4:24 - God is Spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and truth."

Mark 1:11 - And a voice came from the heavens, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

(closing prayer) Philippians 2:6-11

Two

1 Timothy 6:13 - I charge [you] before God, who gives life to all things, and before Christ Jesus, who gave testimony under Pontius Pilate for the noble confession,

John 15:13 - No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends.

John 2:18-19 - At this the Jews answered and said to him, "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up."

(+) 1 Corinthians 15:14-19 - And if Christ has not been raised, then empty [too] is our preaching; empty, too, your faith. Then we are also false witnesses to God, because we testified against God that he raised Christ, whom he did not raise if in fact the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, neither has Christ been raised, and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain; you are still in your sins. Then those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are the most pitiable people of all.

Acts 10:38 - how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

Romans 4:25 - who was handed over for our transgressions and was raised for our justification.

Romans 6:4 - We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life.

Romans 10:9 - for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

John 20:17 - Jesus said to her, "Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" (You can't hold onto a Spirit!)

John 15:15 - I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father.

Hebrews 2:11-12 - He who consecrates and those who are being consecrated all have one origin. Therefore, he is not ashamed to call them "brothers,"

1 Corinthians 15:45 - So, too, it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living being," the last Adam a life-giving spirit. (Jesus)

Three

Mark 16:1-7 - When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary, the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go and anoint him. Very early when the sun had risen, on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb. They were saying to one another, "Who will roll back the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb?" When they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back; it was very large. On entering the tomb they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a white robe, and they were utterly amazed. He said to them, "Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him. But go

and tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him, as he told you.'" (young man = angel)

(+) Acts 2:22 - You who are Israelites, hear these words. Jesus the Nazorean was a man commended to you by God with mighty deeds, wonders, and signs, which God worked through him in your midst, as you yourselves know.

(+) Acts 2:32 - God raised this Jesus; of this we are all witnesses.

(1x) 1 Corinthians 5:7 - Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ, has been sacrificed.

Exodus 12:11 - This is how you are to eat it: with your loins girt, sandals on your feet and your staff in hand, you will eat it in a hurry. It is the LORD's Passover.

1 Peter 2:7 - Therefore, its value is for you who have faith, but for those without faith: "The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,"

(+) 1 Corinthians 15:20-21 - But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a human being, the resurrection of the dead came also through a human being.

Romans 1:5 - Through him we have received the grace of apostleship, to bring about the obedience of faith, for the sake of his name, among all the Gentiles,

Romans 4:24 - it was also for us, to whom it will be credited, who believe in the one who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead,

Acts 2:22-26 - You who are Israelites, hear these words. Jesus the Nazorean was a man commended to you by God with mighty deeds, wonders, and signs, which God worked through him in your midst, as you yourselves know. This man, delivered up by the set plan and foreknowledge of God, you killed, using lawless men to crucify him. But God raised him up, releasing him from the throes of death, because it was impossible for him to be held by it. For David says of him: 'I saw the Lord ever before me, with him at my right hand I shall not be disturbed. Therefore my heart has been glad and my tongue has exulted; my flesh, too, will dwell in hope,

Acts 17:31 - Now all the Athenians as well as the foreigners residing there used their time for nothing else but telling or hearing something new.

Four

From sin to grace

Romans 10:9 - for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Luke 22:19 - Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me."

Exodus 12:42 - This was a night of vigil for the LORD, when he brought them out of the land of Egypt; so on this night all Israelites must keep a vigil for the LORD throughout their generations.

Psalms 3:6 - I lie down and I fall asleep, [and] I will wake up, for the LORD sustains me.

Jeremiah 31:6 - Yes, a day will come when the watchmen call out on Mount Ephraim: "Come, let us go up to Zion, to the LORD, our God."

Psalms 121:4 - Behold, the guardian of Israel never slumbers nor sleeps.

Luke 1:78-79 - because of the tender mercy of our God by which the daybreak from on high will visit us to shine on those who sit in darkness and death's shadow, to guide our feet into the path of peace."

Isaiah 9:1 - The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; Upon those who lived in a land of gloom a light has shone.

Romans 4:25 - who was handed over for our transgressions and was raised for our justification.

(2x) 1 Corinthians 5:7 - Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ, has been sacrificed.

Romans 6:9 - We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him.

John 20:25 - So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

1 Peter 3:18 - For Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the spirit.

Exodus 34:29 - As Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant in his hands, he did not know that the skin of his face had become radiant while he spoke with the LORD.

Five

Exodus 12:26-27 - When your children ask you, 'What does this rite of yours mean?' you will reply, 'It is the Passover sacrifice for the LORD, who passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt; when he struck down the Egyptians, he delivered our houses.'" Then the people knelt and bowed down,

(1x) 1 Peter 2:2 - like newborn infants, long for pure spiritual milk so that through it you may grow into salvation,

John 19:30 - When Jesus had taken the wine, he said, "It is finished." And bowing his head, he handed over the spirit.

Revelations 5:1 (old testament) - I saw a scroll in the right hand of the one who sat on the throne. It had writing on both sides and was sealed with seven seals.

2 Corinthians 5:7 - for we walk by faith, not by sight.

Psalms 69:5 - More numerous than the hairs of my head are those who hate me without cause. Those who would destroy me are mighty, my enemies without reason. Must I now restore what I did not steal?

Matthew 20:28 - Just so, the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Ephesians 1:17 - that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him.

1 Corinthians 1:30 - It is due to him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God, as well as righteousness, sanctification, and redemption,

1 Timothy 2:6 - who gave himself as ransom for all.

Colossians 2:14 - obliterating the bond against us, with its legal claims, which was opposed to us, he also removed it from our midst, nailing it to the cross;

Romans 8:32 - He who did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all, how will he not also give us everything else along with him?

Exodus 12:2 - This month will stand at the head of your calendar; you will reckon it the first month of the year.

(+) 2 Corinthians 5:17 - So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come.

Galatians 6:15 - For neither does circumcision mean anything, nor does uncircumcision, but only a new creation.

Romans 5:20 - The law entered in so that transgression might increase but, where sin increased, grace overflowed all the more,

1 Corinthians 4:1 - Thus should one regard us: as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

Matthew 24:45 - "Who, then, is the faithful and prudent servant, whom the master has put in charge of his household to distribute to them their food at the proper time?"

The Spirit could not die

(vice to virtue; sin to grace)

Exodus 12:15 - For **seven days** you must eat unleavened bread. From the very first day you will have your houses clear of all leaven. For whoever eats leavened bread from the first day to the seventh will be cut off from Israel.

Spring cleaning:

- getting rid of old.
 - Whole and new for Easter –
 - inner house of heart:
 - old: malice and wickedness;
 - new: sincerity and truth.

(1x) 1 Corinthians 5:8 - Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Romans 6:1 - What then shall we say? Shall we persist in sin that grace may abound? Of course not!

(+) 2 Corinthians 5:14 - For the love of Christ impels us, once we have come to the conviction that one died for all; therefore, all have died.

Romans 6:2 - How can we who died to sin yet live in it?

Romans 6:15 - What then? Shall we sin because we are not under the law but under grace? Of course not!

(3x) 1 Corinthians 5:7 - Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ, has been sacrificed

1 John 1:8-9 - If we say, "We are without sin," we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing.

James 3:2 - for we all fall short in many respects. If anyone does not fall short in speech, he is a perfect man, able to bridle his whole body also.

Romans 7:17 - So now it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me.

Romans 6:12-13 - Therefore, sin must not reign over your mortal bodies so that you obey their desires. And do not present the parts of your bodies to sin as weapons for wickedness, but present yourselves to God as raised from the dead to life and the parts of your bodies to God as weapons for righteousness.

1 Peter 4:1 - Therefore, since Christ suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same attitude (for whoever suffers in the flesh has broken with sin),

Romans 6:6 - We know that our old self was crucified with him, so that our sinful body might be done away with, that we might no longer be in slavery to sin.

Psalms 139:1 - LORD, you have probed me, you know me:

Ezekiel 11:19 - And I will give them another heart and a new spirit I will put within them. From their bodies I will remove the hearts of stone, and give them hearts of flesh,

John 3:5 - Jesus answered, "Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit." (Baptism)

(2x) 1 Peter 2:2 - like newborn infants, long for pure spiritual milk so that through it you may grow into salvation,

Matthew 18:3 - and said, "Amen, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.

Ezekiel 36:25-26 - will sprinkle clean water over you to make you clean; from all your impurities and from all your idols I will cleanse you. I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

Ephesians 5:25-27 - Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, cleansing her by the bath of water with the word, that he might present to himself the church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.

Isaiah 52:11 - Depart, depart, go out from there, touch nothing unclean! Out from there! Purify yourselves, you who carry the vessels of the LORD.

Luke 17:21 - and no one will announce, 'Look, here it is,' or, 'There it is.' For behold, the kingdom of God is among you."

Isaiah 58:1 - Cry out full-throated and unsparingly, lift up your voice like a trumpet blast; Proclaim to my people their transgression, to the house of Jacob their sins.

Ezekiel 18:31 - Cast away from you all the crimes you have committed, and make for yourselves a new heart and a new spirit. Why should you die, house of Israel?

Isaiah 1:5 – Why would you yet be struck, that you continue to rebel? The whole head is sick, the whole heart faint.

Acts 2:27-38 - because you will not abandon my soul to the netherworld, nor will you suffer your holy one to see corruption. You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.' My brothers, one can confidently say to you about the patriarch David that he died and was buried, and his tomb is in our midst to this day. But since he was a prophet and knew that God had sworn an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants upon his throne, he foresaw and spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, that neither was he abandoned to the netherworld nor did his flesh see corruption. God raised this Jesus; of this we are all witnesses. Exalted at the right hand of God, he received the promise of the holy Spirit from the Father and poured it forth, as you (both) see and hear. For David did not go up into heaven, but he himself said: 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies your footstool.'" Therefore let the whole house of Israel know for certain that

God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified.” Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and they asked Peter and the other apostles, “What are we to do, my brothers?” Peter [said] to them, **“Repent and be baptized,** every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ **for the forgiveness of your sins;** and you will receive the gift of the holy Spirit.

Zechariah 3:4-5 - Then the angel said to those standing before him, “Remove his filthy garments.” And to him he said, “Look, I have taken your guilt from you, and I am clothing you in stately robes.” Then he said, “Let them put a clean turban on his head.” And they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with the garments while the angel of the LORD was standing by. (confession)

Seven

(4x / 2x) 1 Corinthians 5:7-8 (Christian Passover) - Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough, inasmuch as you are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ, has been sacrificed. Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Corrupt / pure
Sin / life

1 Corinthians 10:1 - I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea,

1 Corinthians 10:2-4 - and all of them were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. All ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they drank from a spiritual rock that followed them, and the rock was the Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:13 - **For in one Spirit** we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

1 Corinthians 10:6 - These things happened as examples for us, so that we might not desire evil things, as they did.

John 2:19 - And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from (although the servers who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter called the bridegroom

1 Corinthians 3:16 - Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

(1x) **1 Peter 3:4** - but rather the hidden character of the heart, expressed in the imperishable beauty of a gentle and calm disposition, which is precious in the sight of God.

Deuteronomy 16:5-6 - You may not sacrifice the Passover in any of the communities which the LORD, your God, gives you; only at the place which the LORD, your God, will choose as the dwelling place of his name, and in the evening at sunset, at the very time when you left Egypt, shall you sacrifice the Passover.

2 Corinthians 6:16 - What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said: "I will live with them and move among them, and I will be their God and they shall be my people.

Isaiah 46:8 - Remember this and be firm, take it to heart, you rebels;

Luke 19:5 - And as for those who do not welcome you, when you leave that town, shake the dust from your feet in testimony against them."

Isaiah 29:13 - The Lord said: Since this people draws near with words only and honors me with their lips alone, though their hearts are far from me, And fear of me has become mere precept of human teaching,

1 Samuel 16:7 - But the LORD said to Samuel: Do not judge from his appearance or from his lofty stature, because I have rejected him. God does not see as a mortal, who sees the appearance. The LORD looks into the heart.

Joel 2:13 - Rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the LORD, your God, For he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love, and relenting in punishment.

Matthew 15:10 - He summoned the crowd and said to them, "Hear and understand.

John 4:24 - God is Spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and truth."

Heart and soul = Spirit

Matthew 6:1-4 - "[But] take care not to perform righteous deeds in order that people may see them; otherwise, you will have no recompense from your heavenly Father. When you give alms, do not blow a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets to win the praise of others. Amen, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing, so that your almsgiving may be secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you.

John 14:17 - If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him."

John 14:23 - Jesus answered and said to him, "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him.

Romans 5:5 - and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the holy Spirit that has been given to us.

Galatians 4:6 - As proof that you are children, God sent the spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

Romans 7:22 - For I take delight in the law of God, in my inner self,

2 Corinthians 4:16 - Therefore, we are not discouraged; rather, although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day.

(2x) 1 Peter 3:4 - but rather the hidden character of the heart, expressed in the imperishable beauty of a gentle and calm disposition, which is precious in the sight of God.

Acts 17:23 - For as I walked around looking carefully at your shrines, I even discovered an altar inscribed, 'To an Unknown God.' What therefore you unknowingly worship, I proclaim to you.

Ephesians 3:17 - and that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, rooted and grounded in love,

Go to the end of the solar – yet not to our hearts (debeers)

Exodus 5:9 - Increase the work for the men, so that they attend to it and not to deceitful words.”

Luke 15:7 – He came to Himself - I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance.

Matthew 8:12 - but the children of the kingdom will be driven out into the outer darkness, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.”

Exodus 33:11 – (Interior) - The LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as a person speaks to a friend. Moses would then return to the camp, but his young assistant, Joshua, son of Nun, never left the tent.

Luke 2:19 - And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart.

God is Spirit

Eight

Luke 16:22 - When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried,

Luke 23:43 - He replied to him, “Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise.”

Colossians 3:1-4 - If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory.

Psalms 90:12 - Teach us to count our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart.

Luke 12:20 - But God said to him, 'You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?'

Sirach 11:19 - When they say: "I have found rest, now I will feast on my goods," They do not know how long it will be till they die and leave them to others.

Ecclesiastes 2:21 - For here is one who has toiled with wisdom and knowledge and skill, and that one's legacy must be left to another who has not toiled for it. This also is vanity and a great evil.

Luke 9:31 - who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem.

John 13:1 - Before the feast of Passover, Jesus knew that his hour had come to pass from this world to the Father. He loved his own in the world and he loved them to the end.

1 Corinthians 15:55-57 - Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:14 - For the love of Christ impels us, once we have come to the conviction that one died for all; therefore, all have died.

Hebrews 2:9 - but we do see Jesus "crowned with glory and honor" because he suffered death, he who "for a little while" was made "lower than the angels," that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Romans 6:3 - Or are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 - Do you not know that your body is a temple of the holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been purchased at a price. Therefore, glorify God in your body.

1 Corinthians 3:22-23 - Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or the present or the future: all belong to you, and you to Christ, and Christ to God.

Jeremiah 23:39 - therefore I will lift you on high and cast you from my presence, you and the city which I gave to you and your ancestors.

Hebrews 2:14-15 - Now since the children share in blood and flesh, he likewise shared in them, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and free those who through fear of death had been subject to slavery all their life.

2 Timothy 2:11 - This saying is trustworthy: If we have died with him we shall also live with him;

John 11:21-26 (Martha) - Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. [But] even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you." Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise." Martha said to him, "I know he will rise, in the resurrection on the last day." Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" (a question from Jesus)

Hebrews 9:27 - Just as it is appointed that human beings die once, and after this the judgment,

1 Corinthians 15:31 - Every day I face death; I swear it by the pride in you [brothers] that I have in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 14:7-8 - None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.

1 Timothy 1:9 - with the understanding that law is meant not for a righteous person but for the lawless and unruly, the godless and sinful, the unholy and profane, those who kill their fathers or mothers, murderers,

Hebrews 13:14 - Let marriage be honored among all and the marriage bed be kept undefiled, for God will judge the immoral and adulterers.

Psalms 49:18 - At his death he will not take along anything, his glory will not go down after him.

Matthew 25:13 - Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour.

1 Samuel 20:3 - But David replied: "Your father is well aware that I am favored with your friendship, so he has decided, 'Jonathan must not know about this or he will be grieved.' Nevertheless, as the LORD lives and as you live, there is only a step between me and death."

Deuteronomy 32:15 - So Jacob ate and was satisfied, Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; you became fat and gross and gorged. They forsook the God who made them and scorned the Rock of their salvation.

Genesis 3:19 - By the sweat of your brow you shall eat bread, Until you return to the ground, from which you were taken; For you are dust, and to dust you shall return.

Isaiah 40:6-8 - A voice says, "Proclaim!" I answer, "What shall I proclaim?" "All flesh is grass, and all their loyalty like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower wilts, when the breath of the LORD blows upon it." "Yes, the people is grass! The grass withers, the flower wilts, but the word of our God stands forever."

Psalms 49:15 - Like a herd of sheep they will be put into Sheol, and Death will shepherd them. Straight to the grave they descend, where their form will waste away, Sheol will be their palace.

2 Timothy 4:2 - proclaim the word; be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient; convince, reprimand, encourage through all patience and teaching.

Revelation 20:6 - Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over these; they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for [the] thousand years.

Matthew 26:41 - Watch and pray that you may not undergo the test. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."

John 13:1 - Before the feast of Passover, Jesus knew that his hour had come to pass from this world to the Father. He loved his own in the world and he loved them to the end.

1 Corinthians 15:56 - The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law.

Luke 12:4-5 - I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body but after that can do no more. I shall show you whom to fear. Be afraid of the one who after killing has the power to cast into Gehenna; yes, I tell you, be afraid of that one.

1 Corinthians 1:20 - Where is the wise one? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made the wisdom of the world foolish?

Romans 12:1 - I urge you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship.

Hebrews 9:14 - how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God.
